The choice is up to us. We can allow the things, cares, concerns and worries of this life to bring us down because they are beyond our control or as the song "What A Friend We Have In Jesus" so wonderfully proclaims; we can take it to the Lord in prayer.


As a Christian we are not immune to the everyday cares and concerns of this world but we have access to powerful weapons that allow us to cast down every lofty imagination that tries to exalt itself against the knowledge of Christ. II Corinthians 10:5 We have the Word of God that is quick, powerful and sharper than any two edged sword Hebrews 4:12 and we have the person of Jesus who like us was tempted in every way, just as we are, yet without sin Hebrews 4:15. If we take advantage of both of these weapons we will not be victims but victors in Christ Jesus.

The night of Jesus' betrayal, He and His disciples journeyed to the Garden called Gethsemane meaning olive oil press or oil valley to pray. Matthew 26:38 reads; The He (Jesus) said to them (disciples), My soul is exceedingly sorrowful, even to death. Stay here and watch with Me. It appears that Jesus was suffering or burdened down with the reality of becoming the lamb of God which takes away the sin of the world John 1:29. In this state of mind Jesus says He is exceedingly sorrowful, even to death. Luke gives us further details in chapter 22:44 and being in agony, He (Jesus) prayed more earnestly. Then His sweat became like great drops of blood falling down to the ground. This sounds like the pressure was mounting on Jesus' life and He was at the point of a breakdown or breakthrough. What got Jesus through this dark moment; it wasn't positive thinking, it wasn't riches and fame, it wasn't friends (they were sleeping) and it wasn't the accolades of this world. If we read on in Matthew 26 we see the answer in vs. 39 and we see where Jesus found the strength to turn a potential breakdown into an eternal breakthrough. It was a personal intimate relationship that He had with His Father. He went a little farther and fell on His face and "prayed", saying, O My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as You will. What is God's will? It is God's Word! Jesus was feeding on God's will/word through prayer to find the strength to have a breakthrough. In Matthew 4:4 Jesus shows us that if we will feed on God's will/word it will give us the strength to turn potential breakdowns into life changing breakthroughs. Jesus answered; It is written, man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.

Our second weapon in the battle is a personal and intimate relationship with Jesus. Matthew 11:28 Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Jesus is letting us know that we can't handle everything that life throws our way and He is giving us a way out of a breakdown and into a breakthrough if we will avail ourselves of this wonderful promise.

Paul under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit put it this way; we are hard-pressed on every side, yet not crushed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed. When challenges come our way lets learn to trust in God's Word and Jesus and not our own strength then those potential breakdowns will become our glorious breakthroughs. Don't give up because your breakthrough is on the way.
